There is also a pilot program that will start in Calvin Hall. We are taking the garbage cans out of the classrooms, and putting recycling bins in the hallways. The facilities department asks that we make sure people don't just leave their trash in the classrooms – they need to take it out to the bins.

We also have a pilot program that we are starting in Student Services – desk-side recycling. The people there will be given a recycling bin for their desk. If you want to try it, let me know. Facilities will not pick the recycling bins up and sort them; each person will have to do it themselves.
